Deed and Land Records

John Denney likely settled on his grant on the Staunton River between 1744 and 1746. At that time the land was in Brunswick County. By the time he received his land grant, the county of Lunenburg had been created and the farm was included.

William Byrd Esquire, [received] 105,000 acres in Brunswick County on both sides Dan River and on both sides of several Brs. of the same Namely Banister River, Medway River, Hiconomy Riv. at a Great Br. of Sugar Tree Creek, along the County line to a white oak marked "WB"...April 16, 1742, p. 239, Pt. Bk 20. Cost: 525 pounds sterling.
