

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA deed March 17, 1757
George Wilcocks of Halifax Co, and Mary his wife, to Thomas Dillard, Jr, of same, for 25 lbs, 100 acres, beginning on the south side of Stanton River below Mush Island, thence west, a place commonly called the bare hows, a large rock of stone on sd river side, line agreed on by both parties. All houses, buildings, fences, orchards, woods. Signed: George (g) Wilcocks, Mary () Wilcocks who relinquished right of dower. Returned 17 March, 1757 (p. 250 Chiarito, Marian Dodson, *Halifax County, Virginia, Deed Book 1: 1752-1759*: Clarkston Press, 1987) p. 23

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA deed April 20, 1757
Valentine Allen of Halifax County, to John Ward of Albemarle County, for 500 lbs, 254 acres on the south side of Stanton River, and is the land said Valentine Allen purchased of Paul Chiles 17 July 1753, of record in Halifax County, bounds thereof described. All houses, outhouses, trees, woods. Richard Jones Halifax 18 Sep 1760 140 acres Hico (Halifax County Deed Book 2, p. 204)

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA Deed May 20, 1762
Isaac Johnson & Susanna, his wife, of Halifax County to Zacharias (also Zacerius) DENNY of same, for 30 pounds, 268 (or is it 286) acres on Coleman's Cr., a branch of the north side of Hico Cr...beg. At Robert Man's line...All houses, buildings, orchards... Signed Isaac Johnson; withn. By Thomas Dillard, Jr. John DENNY, William Hall. (Halifax County, VA, Deed Book 3, p. 281)

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA Deed Nov 25, 1762
James Ham [Hamblet?] of Halifax County, VA, to John Harralson of Albemarle County, VA a tract of land on Black Walnut Branch of Hico Cr. Land Ham had purchased from William Byrd, III. Withn.- Zacharias (his D mark) and T. Lawson, Alex Douglas, John Warren, Robert Holt. Recorded 7-21-1763. (Halifax County Deed Book 4, p. 337) (according to Internet this should be James Hamblett)

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA Deed May 19, 1763
[torn] May [torn] William Byrd of Charles City, Co. to Zachery DENNY of [torn] for L4/3/6 [l = pounds sterling], 330 acres on Colemans Creek beg. At John Warren's cor...DENNY's old corner...All trees, woods, ...David Caldwell by power of attorney for William Byrd...Signed: W. Byrd, no witnesses, recorded May 19, 1763." Large number of deeds all executed by Caldwell for Byrd on May 19, 1763. (Deed Book 4, p. 244 Halifax County Deed Book 4, p. 244)

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA Deed record July 21, 1763

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA land grant 1771
John OWEN. 16 Feb 1771 - 400 acres, on the draughts of Hunts Creek adjoining William OWEN, (Halifax Co., VA. Patents 39, p. 325. <http://198.17.62.51/cgi-bin/drawer/disk19/CC150/0454/O1302?23>)

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA deed June 1783
Peter Rogers paid 5,000 Pounds to Charles Mullins, Sr. for land on Stock Mills Creek, north side of Coleman's Creek adjoining "Turner's Land", to Harrelson's corner on Black Walnut Creek. (Halifax County Deed Book 12, page 297. June 1783)

HALIFAX COUNTY, VA deed Feb 24, 1794
Isham Turner of Halifax County to John Edwards of Halifax County for 200 pounds about 150 acres in Halifax on Evans Creek. Part of land conveyed by William Byrd to John Turner Decd. Bequeathed in will to be equally divided among his heirs & conveyed to Isham Turner bound by Duke Stanfield, the old plantation, Hugh Bragg, James Scott, James Irving, Marma D. Stanfield. Signed Isham Turner. Rec. Feb 24, 1794 No Witnesses. (p. 127 Halifax County Deeds: 1793-1796 p. 127)
