

# LEONARD TAYLOR

## LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

Non cupative will of Leonard Taylor Decd. We David Briant and James W. Rhodes do state that the Noncupative will of Leonard Taylor was made by him on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of 1856 in our presence to which we were especially requested to bear witness by the Testator himself in the presence of each other that it was made in his last sickness in his own habitation and the same is as follows to wit. It was his will and desire that his effects should be disposed of after his decease in the following manner.

1<sup>st</sup> that all my debts should be paid as early as possible, the balance of my effects of every kind after paying my debts I give to my wife Sarah during her natural life and after her death to be equally divided between my children, and request that my neighbor and friend Zachariah Briant will execute this my will made out by us and signed this 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1846.
