

SMITH COUNTY, TENNESSEE CENSUS OF 1830

Much of our Denney family seems strangely absent from the Smith County Census in 1830. It seems that at least a portion of the New Middleton-Bluff Creek area is missing. Many individuals in the census are listed twice, including Charles Denney and James Winfree. James Winfree's household has an additional child in one of the two listings. Our families of interest are listed below.
