

WILL OF AGNES DENNEY SMITH COUNTY, TENNESSEE

(Smith County Will Book E, p. 370)

Will of Agnes Denney, Decd,

Be it remembered that on this the 26 day of Nov 1917, before the Hon. David Hodges, Chairman of the County Court of Smith County, Tenn, N. G. Robertson, Attorney for testator produced in open court a paper writing purporting to be the last will of Agnes Denney, decd bearing date, Nov 3d, 1915, having the name of Agnes Denney, signed thereto and being subscribed by N. G. Robertson and W. H. Minton as attesting Witnesses and moved the court that the same be admitted to probate and record, as and for the last will of the said Agnes Denney, decd and it appearing to the Court from the testimony of N. G. Robertson and W. H. Minton attesting witnesses that said paper writing was written in the lifetime of the said Agnes Denney decd and signed by her and subscribed in his presence and at her request by the said N. G. Robertson and W. H. Minton, subscribing witnesses and that said instrument was executed by the said Agnes Denney on the day it bears date and for her last will and testament and that she was at the time of sound mind and disposing memory And it further appearing that the said Agnes Denney lately died at her usual place of residence in Smith County, Tennessee, it is so adjudged and it is so adjudged and declared by the Court, that said instrument is the true whole and last will of the said Agnes Denney, Dec'd, and the clerk is directed to file and record the same.

Said will is as follows:

Mrs. Agnes Denney publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made. I give and bequeath all property I die seized and possessed of to my beloved Granddaughter Annie Agnes Denney who is with her tender and loving care devoting her life to make me comfortable. Having heretofore given to both of my sons most all of the property I had.
