

WILL OF NANNIE ALEXANDER DENNEY SMITH COUNTY, TENNESSEE

(Smith Count, Tennessee Will Book E pp. 293-294, Smith County Microfilm Reel 106)

Be it remembered that on the 13th day of October 1913 before the Hon G. W. Allen Chairman of the County Court of Smith County, Tennessee, Walter R. Denney the person named as executor therein produced in open court a paper writing purporting to be the last will of Nannie Alexander Denney "deceased" bearing date Sept 9, 1898, having the name of Nannie Alexander Denny Signed thereto, and being subscribed by S. E. Ross and H. H. Beal as attesting witnesses and moved the court that the same be admitted to probate and recorded as the last will and testament of Nannie Alexander Denney deceased. And it appearing to the court from the testimony of the said S. E. Ross one of the subscribing witnesses, that said paper writing was written in the lifetime of the said Nannie Alexander Denney deceased and signed by her and subscribed in her presence and at her request by the said S. E. Ross and H. H. Beal, as attesting witnesses and that said instrument was executed by the said Nannie Alexander Denney on the day it bears date as and for her last will and testament and that she was at the time of Sound mind and disposing memory and it further appearing that the said Nannie Alexander Denney Some years ago died in Trousdale County, Tennessee, and at her usual place of residence, at the time of her death was in said county and state aforesaid, find it appearing is adjudged and declared by the court that said instrument is the true, whole and last will and testament of the said Nannie Alexander Denney deceased. And it appearing to the Court that the will of Nannie Alexander Denney deceased has been probated and recorded in Hartsville Trousdale County, Tennessee, and as a result of such that Court has ordered that J. A. Kemp Clerk, procure a certified copy of said original will from the county court clerk of Trousdale County, to be filed away instead of the original will, and the clerk is directed to file and record the same in the will book in the office of the county court _____ in Carthage Tennessee.

Said will as follows.

Know all men as I do these presents that I Nannie Alexander Denney of Dixon Springs Smith Co. Tenn, being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make and publish this as my last will and testament, hereby revoking all others made heretofore. I bequeath to my husband Walter R. Denney all the real estate I may die seized or possessed of including all of my personal property. I hereby appoint my husband Walter R. Denney _____ executor without bond.
