

WILL OF SARAH ANN DENNEY SMITH COUNTY TENNESSEE

(Smith County Will Book E, p. 154. Smith County Microfilm Roll 106)

Will of Sarah Ann Denny Decd.

Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of June 1905 before the Hon. J. M. Gardenhire Chairman of the County Court of Smith County, Tenn. James T. Denny the person named therein as executor produced in open court a paper writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Sarah Ann Denny deceased bearing date of November 28th 1904 and moved the court that the same be admitted to probate and record as the last will and testament of the said Sarah Ann Denny Decd. and it duly appearing to the satisfaction of the court upon the sworn testimony of J. W. Harel and Geo W. Lynch the attesting witnesses that said paper working was written in the lifetime of the said Sarah Ann Denny Decd and signed by her as and for her last will and testament in the presence of the above named witnesses and that said instrument was executed by the said Sarah Ann Denny Decd. on the date mentioned therein and that she was at the time of sound mind and disposing memory and that the said Sarah Ann Denny has recently died in Smith County Tennessee and at her usual place of residence. It is therefore so ordered and adjudged by the court that said instrument is a true whole and last will and instrument of the said Sarah Ann Denny decd, the clerk of this court is directed to file and record the same.

Said will is in the following words and figures to wit.

I Sarah Ann Denny of Smith County Tennessee do make and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoking any and all wills by me heretofore made first I direct that all my debts be paid by executor as soon after my death as possible. I direct and devise that my husband J. T. Denny shall take absolutely all of my undivided interest in my fathers estate J. W. Agee Deceased both personal property and also my undivided real estate. I direct that my executor shall collect all debts due me and sell all of my estate real and personal upon such terms as in his Judgment he may deem best. I appoint my husband J. T. Denny to be the executor of this will and also excuse him from giving bond this November 28, 1904.
